## Makerspace Safety Guide

**Get "Certified."** Certification is required for individual use of our equipment. Contact your Makerspace for training.

**Focus.** Do not distract others or let yourself be distracted when using tools/equipment.

**Keep hands, fingers, and hair away** from blades or other moving parts of equipment.

## Maintain a safe work area.

- + Keep area free of debris and clutter while working.
- When using blades, always close or cover the blade, if possible, when not in use.
- -- Let hot items cool before handling.
- --- Clean up and return tools after you are finished working.

## Wear proper attire & safety equipment.

- -L. Use appropriate safety equipment as needed.
- + Tie back long hair and avoid dangling jewelry or scarves.
- Wear appropriate clothing and footwear for the activity performed.
- -- Keep sharp tools out of pockets.

Notify staff if you experience an injury or if a tool isn't working right.

**Supervise minors.** Active supervision is highly encouraged for families of all ages. Kids under 14 require active supervision by an adult Makerspace user. Watch for programs specifically planned for younger kids.
