

## PRINT DISABILITY – CORPORATE

Care homes, nursing homes, group homes, and classrooms help their residents and students with print disabilities access special library services by using a corporate card. A staff member using this card takes responsibility for only sharing print disabled materials with qualifying residents or students. Please contact your local library branch if a resident or student wants to borrow material independently.

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

A print disability prevents people from reading print. They gain access to special library services if they have a perceptual disability as described in the Canadian Copyright Act because of:

- Visual disabilities (e.g. blindness; cannot move eyes)
- Physical disabilities (e.g. not able to hold or use a book)
- Comprehension problems (e.g. dyslexia, autism)

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I take responsibility on behalf of my organization for borrowing print disabled with only qualifying residents or students.
